We had 6 individuals attend our first drop-in and received support with a range of issues, including:


- Mobile phones Emailing, texting, adding contacts, downloading videos and pictures.

Our next drop in will be held on Saturday 29th July 2023 from 10:30am-2:30pm.



As part of National Carers Week, RIASS would like to invite you to special information event in partnership with Redbridge Carers Support Service (RCSS).


