OPE is launching a new employment and personal development service - The Talent Network. Its focus is addressing the barriers keeping Deaf and Disabled People furthest from the labour market or from reaching their potential once in work.

This is not your traditional employment project – oh no! Where people are frequently told what they cannot do, The Talent Network will help identify talents, skills and interests and find pathways to employment and training opportunities – including self-employment or enterprise creation.

As with all OPE's work, peer support and connecting Deaf and Disabled People to their community to achieve their ambitions is a core aim of The Talent Network.

Thanks to funding from CABWI, we are able to develop a network of Deaf and Disabled People, employers, education and training providers, employment support agencies, role models, inventors, entrepreneurs and those who are just fun to have around.

The Talent Network is not just for Deaf and Disabled People aged 18 – 65 who currently are not working. It is also for people in work but feel they could further develop or change their career, if only they were supported to achieve their potential. Employers may also want to be involved, getting support in making their business more inclusive.

Our visit to the Dreamachine

On 26th April 2023, Jane Wells and her team from the Dreamachine paid a visit to One Place East to a do a presentation, on the Dreamachine experience. The Dreamachine experience has toured parts of Great Britain, including Edinburgh, Cardiff, Belfast and London. There is a pre-booking form containing information about medical conditions or sensitivities that may be relevant to participation in the High Sensory Dreamachine experience.

On the 12th May 2023, Kate Harrison visited the Dreamachine premises, at Hackney Downs Studios to take part in this exciting experience, and reported below:



"There were six of us taking part in the experiece. We took our shoes off and laid back in very comfy seats and had soft blankets to cover ourselves with. First of all we took part in relaxation and breathing exercises. Then we prepared and took part in the taster session.


My experience (eyes shut tightly) and the bright lights were flashing, I saw like a kaleidoscope of images. Which were hexagons and diamond shapes in red and yellow. The extended version again I saw hexagon shapes and diamonds in vivid colours – yellows, oranges and red colours. It almost looked like a bees honey comb pattern.

Afterwards, I was invited to share my feedback of what I saw and how I felt during the process. There were slate boards and pastels provided so that we could draw what we had seen. The whole experience was truly magical.

The following day, I went to the Hackney Downs Studios again for their Science Day. The aim of this project is to investigate the neural effects of the Dreamachine experience simultaneously across mutiple users. I was set up for an electroephalogram (EEG), which provides a readout of online brain activity. I wore a snug fitting cap, made of elasticated cloth and some metal sensors. In order to establish contact between the scalp and the sensors it is necessary to apply an electrolyte gel, that contains conductive salts, which takes about half an hour to complete.

During the Dreamachine session it followed the same routine as on the 12th. During the taster main event I saw white smoke and it felt serene and dreamy. I did not see any colours or shapes this time. I completed a survey and talked about my experiences.

I found the entire Dreamachine experience exciting and wonderful. I would like to give a special thankyou to Jane Wells and Dr David Schwartzman and the many others working for Dreamachine for allowing me to take part.
