



YOU COULD GET £150 OFF YOUR ELECTRICTY UNDER THE WARM HOME DISCOUNT SCHEME



You could get £150 off your electricity bill for winter 2023 to 2024 under the Warm Home Discount Scheme. The money is not paid to you – it's a one–off discount applied to your electricity bill between early October 2023 and 31 March 2024. You'll usually get the discount automatically if you're eligible.

If you might be eligible, you'll get a letter by early January 2024. If you do not get a letter and you think you're eligible, you must contact the Warm Home Discount Scheme before 29 February 2024 through the gov.uk website.



You may be able to get the discount on your gas bill instead if your supplier provides you with both gas and electricity and you're eligible. Contact your supplier to find out.





DATE FOR AUTUMN £300 COST OF LIVING PAYMENT ANNOUNCED

The DWP will make the second 2023 Cost of Living payment of £300 to eligible claimants between 31 October and 19 November. This is the second of three payments over the financial year, totalling up to £900. Eligible pensioner households will also receive a further £300 payment later this year as an addition to the Winter Fuel payment.

Eligible tax credits-only customers who do not qualify for a payment from DWP will receive £300 from HMRC between 10 and 19 November. Claimants will receive the payments automatically. They do not need to contact DWP or do anything to receive the payment
